A Congressional Resolution: Eliminate ERA's Ratification Time Limit—Let's Finish What We Started!

Equal Rights Amendment (ERA)

*Equality of rights under the law shall not be denied or abridged
by the United States or by any state
on account of sex*

To Individuals and Organizations Dedicated to Equal Rights for All:

Discrimination based on race, religion and national origin is prohibited by the United States Constitution. Yet sex discrimination is still allowed. Did you know that thirty-five states have already passed the Equal Rights Amendment? Only three more states are required to end sex discrimination and guarantee all women and girls equality and justice under the U.S. Constitution!

Without the ERA, sex discrimination grievances must be addressed through costly legal battles. Women must fight issue by issue; case by case; over and over again with no certainty of outcome. This is neither equality nor justice.

Congresswoman Tammy Baldwin (D-WI) and Senator Benjamin Cardin (D-MD), on behalf of United For Equality and its coalition members, are spearheading a new resolution to revive the original ERA before Congress.

The new ERA resolution seeks to:

- Eliminate the 1982 time limit so that a path to equality exists in perpetuity.
- Pave the way for the final three states to ratify the ERA as the 28th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution.
